Shelves must be loaded evenly, and load heavier items on the bottom shelves




Never climb or stand on the shelves.



ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 1: ASSEMBLING THE CASTERS

Screw each Caster (G) into the bottom of each Bottom Pole (D). Turn clock-wise to screw in place. Screw in tightly.




STEP 2: SLIP SLEEVES

On the Bottom Pole (D), place 1 pair of slip sleeves (E) at the desired level. Please make sure the arrow faces up and that the word "top" is right side up. Do this for each Bottom Pole (D) and make sure that the heights are identical for Bottom Pole (D).

Slide the pair of Slip Sleeves (E) until you hear a click to confirm the pair is locked onto the Bottom Pole (D).Do not place more than one pair on each Pole (D) at a time.

**Note: There will be a very small gap in-between the Slip Sleeves (E) -this is normal.




STEP 3: INSTALLING THE BASKET

Place The Basket (B) on its side and slide the Bottom Pole (G) through the holes in the Basket (B). Make sure that the Basket (B) corner cylinders are positioned over the Slip sleeves (E). Stand the unit upright.


**Use a rubber mallet, if needed, to secure the Basket(B).






STEP 4 INSTALLING TOP POLES

Screw the Top Pole (C) into the Bottom Pole (D). The tops of these poles are indicated by the black end up.




STEP 5: INSTALLING THE RUBBERWOOD TOP

Repeat Step 2 for the Rubberwood Top (A) and place the slip sleeves (E) at the highest position. Slide Rubberwood Top onto the Slip Sleeves (E).



STEP 6: INSTALLING THE SIDEBAR

Place the sidebar (F) on the poles as shown.
